What makes a good souvenir?

On my desk at home, I have a collection of souvenirs; objects that (0) me of places I've visited and important events in my life. It's often the (9) that the best souvenirs, like my shell, are found rather than purchased, but (10) for souvenirs can also be a fun holiday activity. But if you are buying souvenirs on holiday this summer, make sure they (11) the reality test. A good souvenir is not just made in the area where it is bought, it also says something about the culture of that area. It is something made by local people using sustainable local materials, and because you are effectively supporting the local economy, it shouldn't (12) too cheap, either.


